As a Seniors Resource Coordinator, the successful candidate will work with a team that receives, assesses, and addresses reports of elder abuse in Edmonton. It is essential the successful candidate has strong collaboration skills in order to work closely with clients, police, and other agencies to provide quality assistance to seniors at risk or experiencing abuse. You will work with professionals, concerned community members, family members and the seniors themselves. Using analytical skills and good judgment, the successful candidate will work collaboratively within the Elder Abuse Intervention Team to assess high risk cases and provide support to clients and families in need. The ability to understand cross-cultural family dynamics will be beneficial in order to assess cases of elder abuse, and to provide intervention with a multi-disciplinary team of professionals. Strong communication skills are an asset, as you will be required to raise community awareness of this issue through presentations, writing articles, and attending community events.

A degree in Social Work and two years of experience working with seniors and family violence intervention is preferred, however a degree in a related Human Service field will also be considered for this rewarding and challenging role. A vehicle and valid Operator's licence is required, as well as an enhanced security clearance.
